Classes are taught by qualified swim teachers and lifeguards, ensuring that children learn effectively and in an environment of utmost safety. The programme follows stringent safety standards and child protection policies. It promotes confidence and a sense of security, ensuring every child feels safe, valued, and encouraged regardless of their swimming proficiency.
