We are very excited to share that we have organised two exciting experiences for our Year 5 pupils.

VIKING HISTORY WORKSHOP

We have arranged for Year 5 to take part in a Viking History Workshop as part of our current topic in history. The visit will take place on **Monday 7th October 2024** in the school hall.

The children will go deep into the world of the Vikings and find out about topics such as: Introduction to the Vikings; Gods; Laws of the Lands; Lindisfarne; Valhalla; Warfare; Longboats. We will be looking at artefacts, playing games, and taking part in drama, discussion, role play and a quiz, as well as making a piece of Viking jewellery.

We encourage the children to dress up as a Viking for the day, if they would like to – there are some ideas overleaf. No weapons please!

THE ASTRONOMY ROADSHOW

We have also arranged for Year 5 to receive a visit from The Astronomy Roadshow as part of our Space topic in science. The Astronomy Roadshow are the UK's largest mobile planetarium system. The children will learn all about a number of space related topics including: Phases of the moon; Gravity; Changing day lengths; Milky Way; Light Pollution.

The visit will take place on Thursday 7th November 2024 in the school hall.

PAYMENT
