We are very excited to tell you about a residential visit we are planning for March 2026, when your child is in Year 6.

We would like to take the children to Stone Farm Study Centre, Okehampton in Devon for 4 nights from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March to Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2026.

Stone Farm is located on the edge of Dartmoor in the heart of the Devon countryside. They are a working farm of 110 acres and in a perfect location in the foothills of the National Park. <u>https://www.stonefarmstudycentre.co.uk/</u>

We have worked hard to find a venue for our visit that is both educational, engaging and fun for the children as well as allowing them to build important connections with their peers and gain their independence whilst away from their parents/carers. We are keen for all the children in the year group to come along so please come and talk to us if you have any questions or concerns.

We understand the financial pressures families are under, and this is why we have decided to arrange something now. The payment will be split into more manageable instalments and we are happy to consider individual payment plans.

We are currently finalising plans and costs but are hoping to bring this trip in under £400.00. This amount includes all coach travel, food, accommodation at the farm entrance fees and activities for The Eden Project and the tree surfing activity, the falconry display and evening activities.

## Day One:
